Class	Description
1	Ground Poles: Dressage 2015 USDF Intro A (Not a USEA test). Jump Course – Ground Poles only. 12-15 obstacles. Leader allowed if prior arrangement made with show management.
2	Ground Poles jumping only (will not be timed or pinned)
3	Cross Rails – Dressage 2015 USDF Intro C (not a USEA test). Jump Course Maximum height 18”, approx 12 to 15 obstacles.
4	Cross Rails jumping only (will not be timed or pinned)
5	Intro Beginner Novice – Dressage 2014 Beg. Novice A. Jump Course – Max height 2’3”, approx 12 to 15 obstacles Water and ditches optional
6	Intro Beginner Novice jump only. (will not be timed or pinned)
7	Beginner Novice –Dressage USEA Dressage A. Jump Course – Max height 2’7”, approx 12 – 15 obstacles, water and ditches optional.
8	Beginner Novice Jump only (Will not be timed or pinned)
9	Novice – Dressage – 2014 USEA Novice A. Jump Course – max height 2’11”. Approx 14 – 16 obstacles. Water and ditche obstacle
10	Novice Jump only (Will not be timed or pinned)
11	Training– Dressage – 2014 USEA Training A. Jump Course – max height 3’3””. Approx 16-18 obstacles. Water and ditch obstacles
12	Training Jump only (Will not be timed or pinned)
13	Training/Prelim– Dressage – 2014 USEA Prelim A. Jump Course – max height 3’7””. Approx 16-20 obstacles. Water and ditche obstacles
14	Training/Prelim Jump only (Will not be timed or pinned)
15	Dressage Test only – TOC to be identified with entry.

Karen Lende O'Connor was born on February 17, 1958 in Bolton, Massachusetts, USA to Phillip and Joanne Lende. She was the second child of three and the only girl; her brothers are Steven and Chip but did not come from a family of equestrians. For Karen's 11th birthday, she received a horse named Midnight. She was a member of the United States Pony Clubs, in the Groton Pony Club in the Central New England Region. She later owned a Connemara pony named Erin's Shamrock, who in 1978 was awarded the Camlin Trophy by the American Connemara Pony Society "in recognition of a career of outstanding competitive performance." Erin's Shamrock carried Karen from a D-1 Pony Clubber to her A rating at the age of 16. It was also the Pony Club that sparked her interest in evening and, after reading an article about Princess Anne winning the European Championships in 1971, Karen became forever hooked on the sport. Karen was inducted into the United States Pony Club Hall of Fame.

Karen began competing internationally in the late 1970's. Her first major placing came at the Badminton CCI4* on March Brown in 1979. In 1986 she started riding with the U.S. Equestrian Team, beginning with the World Championships, which were held in Gawler, Australia, where she rode Lutin V. She won multiple CCI3* events, including the Rolex Kentucky Three Day Event, Punchestown, Foxhall, and twice at the Fair Hill International. Karen won the 1999 Rolex Kentucky CCI4* riding Prince Panache.

Karen has competed in five Olympic Games. At the 1988 Olympics in Seoul, South Korea she rode The Optimist but did not finish. At the 1996 Summer Olympics, in Atlanta riding Biko she was a member of the silver medal team. At the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, riding Prince Panache, Karen was a member of the team that won the bronze medal. At the 2003 Pan American Games, Karen won the individual silver medal riding Joker's Wild.
