

## **IDEA SHOW REBATE PROGRAM- 2012**

The Idaho Dressage and Eventing Association's mission is to educate and promote the sports of dressage and eventing. To that end we wish to inspire our members to put on successful dressage and eventing competitions by offering a "rebate" to any show management who put on an IDEA recognized show in Idaho. IDEA show rebates will be offered on a year to year basis, depending on available funds and the success of the program. All of the guidelines listed below must be met to receive the rebate. The money will be dispersed within 4 weeks after the paperwork is received and is subject to the show following the IDEA rules for all approved shows.

### **SHOW REBATE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. You must publish your prize list in the IDEA Omnibus or submit your prize list to the IDEA Bits and Paces newsletter to distribute to our members and pay for the reproduction costs. (\*NOTE: as of 2008 your IDEA Approval fee of \$75. will be waived if you choose to have an IDEA approved show and purchase an Omnibus page(s).
2. You must fulfill what you publish. Amendments may be made only if changes are voted on by a majority IDEA Board vote.
3. The show manager must be an IDEA member.
4. You must follow the current rules for IDEA approved shows (See 2010 Omnibus) and submit your results to the competitions chair within the 10 days following your competition.
5. Management must fill out the rebate fulfillment page honestly. Any confirmed discrepancies will result in no rebate awarded, plus a fine of \$100 to the show.

### **IDEA SHOW REBATES:**

**"Local" IDEA recognized dressage or eventing competition(s): \$500. per weekend**

**IDEA nationally recognized dressage or eventing competition(s): \$1,000. per weekend**

(Nationally recognized IDEA competitions must also be recognized USEF and either USDF or USEA respectively)

Nationally recognized shows must also include a copy of their TD report.
